




- Cancel on or prior to February 14, 2025 50% Refund
- Cancel between February 15 and March 14, 2025 25% Refund

If at any time SHRM California, the State of California, or the venue determines that the event will not be held due to health concerns related to COVID-19 or other unforeseen pandemics or disasters, you will be entitled to a 90% refund.



Helpful Information

SETUP & TEAR DOWN DAYS/TIMES

Sponsors must check-in at the Conference Registration Desk, street level, prior to set-up. Ample time will be provided before and after the event for Sponsors/Exhibitors to setup and tear down. Specific access and scheduling details will be provided closer to the event. Sponsors and Exhibitors MUST wear conference name badges to have access into the ballroom. The booth remains in place throughout the entire conference in the same location and tear down MAY NOT begin until the conclusion of the Conference at 12:45 on Friday, 4/25/25.

ELECTRICITY & INTERNET

Sponsors wishing to have electricity will order it on their sponsorship agreement. Any need for electrical must be ordered with SHRM California immediately to ensure availability. SHRM California has secured a wireless access for our attendees and all sponsors/exhibitors may also use this access.

FOOD & BEVERAGE

Sponsors are included in all scheduled food and beverage services for the conference, including the Wednesday and Thursday night Reception. The number of Sponsor representatives is dependent on the Sponsorship Level and all sponsor representatives must be registered.
